1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation –**
3 **Baltimore City Sheriff's Office – \$121,308**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the
5 amount of \$121,308 to the Baltimore City Sheriff's Office – Service 882 (Deputy Sheriff
6 Enforcement), to provide funding for diversion services, treatment access, and overdose
7 response within the Sheriff's Office; and providing for a special effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the State of Maryland's
15 Governor's Office of Crime Prevention and Policy in excess of the revenue relied on by the
16 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
17 2026.

18 That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
19 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.

20 On April 15, 2026, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
21 Council.

Council Bill 26-0183

1 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
2 \$121,308 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Sheriff’s Office – Service 882 (Deputy
3 Sheriff Enforcement) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
4 2026, to provide funding for diversion services, treatment access, and overdose response within
5 the Sheriff’s Office. The source of revenue for this appropriation is a grant from the State of
6 Maryland’s Governor’s Office of Crime Prevention and Policy in excess of the amount from this
7 source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
8 balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

9 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
10 enacted.
