1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Impounding Areas – East Cross Street and Hollins Street**

3 FOR the purpose of designating the unit block of East Cross Street and the 1100 block of Hollins
4 Street as impounding areas; and generally relating to clear streets and impoundment.

5 BY adding

6 Article 31 - Transit and Traffic
7 Section(s) 31-73(18a) and 31-78(3a)

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

14 **Subtitle 31. Clear Streets and Impoundment**

15 *Part 7. Impounding Areas*

16 **§ 31-73. “C” streets and areas.**

17 (18A) CROSS STREET, BOTH SIDES OF THE UNIT BLOCK OF EAST CROSS STREET.

18 **§ 31-78. “H” streets and areas.**

19 (3A) HOLLINS STREET, BOTH SIDES OF THE 1100 BLOCK OF HOLLINS STREET.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
21 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
22 Ordinance.

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1 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
2 after the date it is enacted.
