<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Sale of Property - 801 Braddish Avenue

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 801 Braddish Avenue (Block 2373, Lot 001) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.
