The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0521 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill replaces the now defunct Better Greenmount Alliance, one of the constituent groups named in the City Code as entitled to be represented on the Charles Village Community Benefits District Board, with the Waverly Merchants Association.
