3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, ar			
4	operation of a banquet hall on the property known as 3932-3934 Frederick Avenue, as			
5	outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That			
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a banquet hall on the			
13	property known as 3932-3934 Frederick Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this			
14	Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(9) and 14-102, subject to			
15	the condition that the following conditions:			
16	1. The banquet hall must close no later than 1:00 a.m. for Friday, Saturday and Sunday			
17	night events and must close no later than 9:00 p.m. for Monday through Thursday			
18	night events.			
19	2. No application for a liquor license shall be submitted for use on the premises, except			
20	a 1-day liquor license obtained solely in connection with events occurring at the			
21	banquet hall.			
22	3. The sale of tickets, equivalent evidence of payment of a fee for admission, or the			
23	charging of any fee to the general public for admission for events that include live			
24	entertainment, dancing, or both is prohibited in the banquet hall.

1 2	<u>4.</u>	No portion of the property may be used as a night club, after-hours establishment, or adult entertainment business.
3 4 5	<u>5.</u>	The maximum number of persons permitted in the banquet hall at any one time is 160 or a lesser number as determined by the Baltimore City Fire Department, and the number must be posted in a conspicuous manner on the property.
6 7	<u>6.</u>	Adequate security personnel must be present in and around the banquet hall during weekend and midweek events, as may be appropriate.
8 9 10	<u>7.</u>	The banquet hall operator or designee must immediately report any loitering on or about the property to the Baltimore City Police Department and must cooperate in any way possible to facilitate resolution of complaints.
11 12	<u>8.</u>	Sound levels of entertainment provided in connection with events at the banquet hall may not exceed 80 decibels measured at a distance of 10 feet from the property.
13 14 15 16	<u>9.</u>	The banquet hall must maintain a minimum of 16 off-street parking spaces at 316 South Loudon Avenue or a minimum of 16 off-street parking spaces at another lawfully established location within 300 feet of the property known as 3932-3934 Frederick Avenue.
17 18	<u>10</u>	<u>The</u> banquet hall <u>complies</u> <u>must comply</u> with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.
