18 19 20 21	The sum of \$4,109,177, as appropriated to the MR: Employees' Retirement Contribution (Service 355 - Employees' Retirement Contribution) in the Fiscal 2017 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.
