Re: **City Council Bill 16-0639 – Late-Night Commercial Operations –
Extended Scope**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0639, for the purpose of extending the licensing, regulation, and related requirements governing late-night commercial operations to the B-3 Business Zoning District.

If enacted, this bill would extend the license requirements to the B-3 zoning district. As a result, additional resources for notifying, issuing and enforcing the new license requirements may be necessary for the Department of Finance and the Baltimore Police Department.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection and respectfully defers to the Department of Finance and the Baltimore Police Department on the passage of City Council Bill 16-0639.
