Zoning – Conditional Use – Crematorium

3 FOR the purpose of creating a stand-alone use in the Zoning Code for crematoriums; amending
4 certain related definitions; revising certain zoning tables to include the use “crematorium”;
5 making conforming changes; providing for a special effective date; and generally related to
6 creating the stand-alone use “crematorium” in the Zoning Code.

15 “Funeral home” includes:

16 [(i) chapels for viewing a deceased and for conducting rituals; and]

17 [(ii) a crematorium.]

18 (I) A CHAPEL FOR VIEWING A DECEASED AND FOR CONDUCTING RITUALS; AND

19 (II) SALES FACILITIES.
