A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation –**  
3 **Department of Transportation – \$2,000,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the  
5 amount of \$2,000,000 to the Department of Transportation – Service 690 (Complete Streets  
6 and Sustainable Transportation), to provide funding to support Charm City Circulator  
7 operations; and providing for a special effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Transit  
15 Administration in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the  
16 tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

17 That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of  
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated.

19 On June 11, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City  
20 Council.

21 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
22 \$2,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Service 690 (Complete  
23 Streets and Sustainable Transportation) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation  
24 for Fiscal Year 2014, to provide funding to support Charm City Circulator operations. The  
25 source of revenue for this appropriation is a grant from Maryland Transit Administration in  
26 excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in  
27 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.
