REQUEST TOPIC	Opioid Restitution Fund Named Program Grants

Background

At the Public Health and Environment Committee hearing on January 21, 2026, Chairwoman Porter requested information on Opioid Restitution Fund grants issued to programs named in settlement agreements with opioid manufacturers and distributors. These are referred to as “named programs.”

Response

Request #1: Please provide a copy of the grant agreement(s)

Request #2: Please provide the scope of work agreements for the 22 named organizations (grantees)

Request #3: List of any organizations that have “corrective action plans”

The Recovery Office has not issued corrective action plans for any ORF grantees at this time.
