The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0765-Special Event Parking-Zoning-Licensing and Regulation. The bill proposes to provide for the licensing and regulation of special event parking lots and related issues.

As discussed in the report from the Department of Finance, policy issues surrounding this legislation do included the safety and security of citizens and their property. The application requirements in the bill for obtaining a license include that a security plan be adopted and thereby place a necessary measure of responsibility and accountably on the applicant for the public safety issues surrounding the operation of the lot.
