The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #11-0302R, which is for the purpose of requesting the Commissioner of Housing to submit to the City Council regular reports on progress toward the goal of providing inclusionary housing for the residents of Baltimore City; directing the reports be submitted to the Committee of the Whole every 90 days; and requiring implementation of the Inclusionary Progress Report program beginning on September 1, 2011, and continuing until the goals set forth in the legislation have been met to the satisfaction of the members of the City Council and the citizens of Baltimore City.

The Department of Planning takes no position on this bill, and defers to the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development (HCD) as it directly affects the work of the Department of Housing and Community Development pursuant to the Inclusionary Housing ordinance.
