City Council Bill 11-0750 - City Streets - Closing - Eager Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0750, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Eager Street, extending from Chester Street, Easterly 266.6 feet, more or less, to Collington Avenue and lying with in the Middle East urban Renewal Project, as shown on Plat 341-A-43A in the Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

This bill is related to the site assembly for the construction of the New East Baltimore School, a public charter school serving grades PreK-8 in the East Baltimore Development Incorporated (EBDI) section of the city adjacent to the Johns Hopkins medical campus.
