2 3	The Curtis Bay Energy Limited Partnership operates a medical waste incinerator in Hawkins Point, Baltimore City. The City recognizes the importance of safe and	
4	efficient waste disposal facilities.	
5	This Ordinance is necessary to enhance the cogeneration capacity and capabilities	
6	of the waste-to-energy facility and is otherwise in the public interest.	
7 8	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF	
12	BALTIMORE, That permission is hereby granted to Medical Waste	
13	Associates, a Maryland Limited Partnership, for the construction and	
14	operation of an incinerator for the disposal of special medical waste on the	
15	property located at 3204-3214 Hawkins Pt. Road, as outlined in red on the	
16	plats accompanying this [ordinance] ORDINANCE, under the provisions of	
17	Sections 7-3-1cc-5 and 11.0-6d of Article 30 of the Baltimore City Code	
18	(1983 Replacement Volume, as amended)] ZONING CODE §§ 7-408 AND	
19	14-102, and subject to final licensure by the State Department of the	
20	Environment.	
21	[Sec. 2. And be it further ordained, That the use of the	
22	incinerator, including testing and any use under any reciprocal agreement	
23	with any other waste disposal site or incinerator, will be restricted to	
24	facilities located within 250 miles of the city limits of Baltimore City.]

28	that is served by this medical waste incinerator and that is located outside of	
29	the area originally authorized by Section 2 if Ordinance 89-323 shall not serve	
30	as a pass through or medical waste transfer facility for any medical waste	
31	generated outside of the area authorized by this or any other Ordinance.]	
32	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That Sections 3 through 6 of Ordinance	
33	89-323, as amended by Ordinances 93-224 and 97-127, are renumbered to be Sections 2 through	
34	5 of Ordinance 89-323.	
35	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it	
36	is enacted.
