11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

16 **§ 71-1. Appointment; duties.**

17 (a) *Agency certification; appointment.*

18 The following officials shall from time to time certify to the Police Commissioner the
19 names of employees of their respective departments for appointment by the Police
20 Commissioner as Special Enforcement Officers:

21 (1) Commissioner of Health.

22 (2) Chief of the Fire Department.

23 (3) Director of Public Works.
