6 Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
7 Section 18A-1, to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors –  
8 2020s”

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

15 **SUBTITLE 18A. LANDMARK LIST: EXTERIORS – 2020S**

16 **§ 18A-1. REED CALLOWAY HOUSE.**

17 REED CALLOWAY HOUSE, 1316 NORTH CAREY STREET.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
19 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
20 Ordinance.

21 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
22 after the date it is enacted.
