Subject: City Council Bill 21-0122

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 21-0122 introduced by Council President Nick J. Mosby at the request of Baltimore City Department of Transportation.

The purpose of this bill is to grant a franchise to The Johns Hopkins University (Developer's Agreement #1719) to construct, use, and maintain 5 utilities/ductbanks under Wyman Park Drive.

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City (PABC) has reviewed the proposed legislation. The legislation does not reference parking. A site visit was conducted in September of 2021. PABC manages a section of curb on the east side of Wyman Park Drive, north of Bowman Drive, with a parking meter. Based on the plat entitled Private Utilities Under Wyman Park Drive dated August 2020, the PABC meter should not be impacted.

Based on the comments above, the PABC does not oppose the passage of City Council Bill 21-0122.
