allowed for certain accessory shop uses in an Office-Residence District.

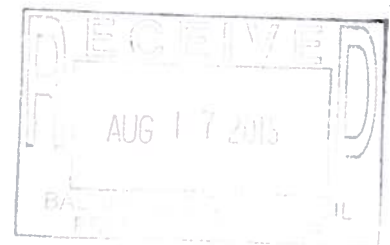
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and has no objection to the passage of Bill
