## Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Resolution 12-0077R has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of City Council Resolution 12-0077R is to request the General Assembly to adopt, and the Governor sign, legislation that would allow Baltimore City community associations the same access to the State court system for zoning disputes enjoyed by community associations in other Maryland jurisdictions.
