


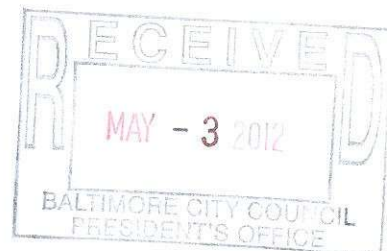

The proposed legislation would provide for the purpose of allowing in certain zoning districts residential substance-abuse treatment facilities as a conditional use requiring an ordinance or, under certain circumstances, as a permitted use; requiring a certain number of off-street parking spaces for these facilities; authorizing the Zoning Administrator, under certain circumstances, to provide reasonable accommodation in the application of the Zoning Code to individuals protected under certain federal laws; defining certain terms; repealing certain obsolete or obsolescent provisions governing the authorization of health facilities; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the siting, development, and use of residential substance-abuse treatment facilities.

The Fire Department does not object to City Council Bill # 12-0055.
