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**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Zoning – Conditional Use Community Correction Center –  
4900 East Monument Street**

FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a community correction center on the property known as 4900 East Monument Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a community correction center on the property known as 4900 East Monument Street, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 7-408(1) and 14-102, subject to the condition that the community correction center complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That Volunteers of America Chesapeake, Inc., are responsible for the operation and control of the facility pursuant to a 10-year contract with the Federal Bureau of Prisons.

**SECTION 2 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
