FOR the purpose of designating the Greater Faith Baptist Church, 3000-3004 Huntingdon Avenue, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2010s

§ 17A-37. GREATER FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH.

GREATER FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH, 3000-3004 HUNTINGDON AVENUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
