
I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0143R.

Informational Hearing – Preparations for Major Events and Festivals – Improving Notification Procedures for Road Closings and Other Preparations

For the purpose of inviting representatives of the Parking Authority of Baltimore City, the Baltimore Office of Promotion and the Arts, the Mayor’s Office of Neighborhoods, the Department of Recreation and Parks, the Department of Transportation, the Department of Public Works, and the Department of General Services to a City Council hearing to brief the Council on the procedures in place for notifying communities about road closings, meter bagging, and other preparations for major events, and to discuss possible methods for improving these procedures.

The Department of Transportation issues press releases and contacts affected community associations regarding closures and other preparations for major events and festivals. DOT has no objections to the passage of the bill and looks forward to participating in the hearing process.
