3	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Capital Fund Appropriation in the amount of
4	\$1,407,000 to the Department of Housing and Community Development, to provide funding
5	for the demolition and stabilization of blighted properties; and providing for a special
6	effective date.

12	Recitals
13	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Simulated Slots
14	(\$573,000), Miscellaneous Citation and Penalty Amounts (\$17,000), and the Annual Nonprofit
15	Contribution (\$817,000) in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in
16	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.
24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$1,407,000 shall be made available to the Department of Housing and Community Development
