I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 10 - 0592 introduced by Councilmember Stokes.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Oldtown was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 70 - 760 and last amended by Ordinance 07 - 498.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Oldtown to allow a conditional use, upon approval by separate ordinance, on the property known as 533/535 Oldtown Mall; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has determined that this amendment will result in no negative impact to parking in the Oldtown area and, therefore, supports the passage of City Council Bill 10 - 0592.
