relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2024.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$6,973,547 shall be made available to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 646 (Park Maintenance) as a Supplementary Special Revenue General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2024, to provide funding for overspending on contractual services and overtime in Urban Forestry, Park Maintenance. The source of revenue for this appropriation is Income Tax - State Collected in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2024.
