Re: **City Council Bill 13-0251 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Messiah English Lutheran Church**

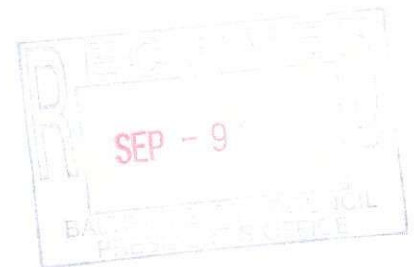
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0251, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Messiah English Lutheran Church, 1025 South Potomac Street, as a historical landmark.

This bill, if enacted, would add the property known as 1025 South Potomac Street—the Messiah English Lutheran Church—to the Baltimore City Landmark List. The subject property is located in the Canton neighborhood on Canton Square.
