15	(2) DO NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL REVENUES OF THE CITY; AND
16	(3) THEIR APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
