Re: **City Council Bill 08-0198 City Streets - Closing - Callendar Street**

---

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0198, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Callendar Street, extending from Baltimore Street, Southerly 137.4 feet, more or less, to Booth Street, as shown on Plat 114-A-45 in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

The proposed legislation and its companion bills (City Council Bills 08-0197 and 08-0199) are components of the process to open, close, and authorize the sale of Callendar Street. The University of Maryland, Baltimore will be constructing a new medical research facility on the southeast corner of West Baltimore and South Poppleton Streets as part a 10 acre BioPark. The new building requires a portion of the footprint of Callendar Street, which necessitates the sale of the street.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 08-0198.
