17	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2009 was formulated.		
18	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the		
19	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2009 was formulated or is for a new program that could		
20	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.		
21	On January 28, 2009, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City		
22	Council.		
23	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That		
24	\$3,021,730 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Program 234 (Transit		
25	and Marine Services) as a Supplementary Special Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
