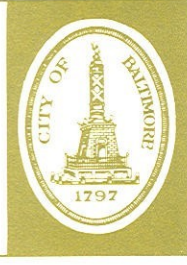

The Department of Transportation (DOT) has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0302 Parking Facilities-Enforcement. The bill, if passed, would increase certain criminal penalties and provide for civil fines for offenders of laws regulating parking facilities.

DOT has no objection to regulation of parking facilities. We are aware that there are some facilities that operate outside of the existing regulatory system and we applaud the sponsor for his efforts to curtail those activities. We defer to the Department of Law for legal sufficiency.
