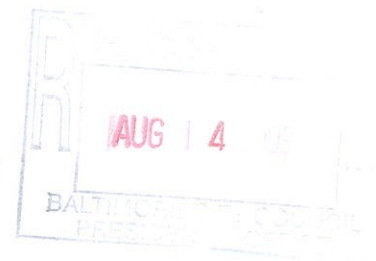


I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09-0363 introduced by The Council President, Stephanie Rawlings-Blake at the request of The Administration (Department of Public Works).

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets lying within the Uplands Apartment Complex and bounded by Edmondson Avenue, Athol Avenue, Pen-Lucy Road and Uplands Parkway and are no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. reviewed the proposed legislation and determined there would be no operational or fiscal impact to any administered parking programs for on-street parking activity and/or City-owned off-street parking facilities. The Parking Authority will work with the Developer through the Site Plan Review process to make sure sufficient parking is planned as part of this redevelopment.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09-0363.



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
