1 AN ORDINANCE concerning 2 City Streets – Opening – **Lemmon Street** 3 FOR the purpose of condemning and opening Lemmon Street, extending from Greene Street 4 Easterly 330.0 feet, more or less, to Paca Street, and lying within the Market Center West 5 Revitalization Area, as shown on Plat 114-A-13 in the Office of the Department of Public 6 Works; and providing for a special effective date. 7 By authority of 8 9 Article I - General Provisions Section 4 10 and 11 Article II - General Powers 12 Sections 2, 34, and 35 13 Baltimore City Charter 14 15 (1996 Edition) SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 16 Department of Public Works shall proceed to condemn and open Lemmon Street, extending from 17 Greene Street Easterly 330.0 feet, more or less, to Paca Street, and lying within the Market 18 Center West Revitalization Area, and more particularly described as follows: 19 Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the south 20 side of Lemmon Street, 20 feet wide, and the east side of Greene Street, 66 feet 21 wide, and running thence binding on the east side of said Greene Street, Northerly 22 20.0 feet to intersect the north side of said Lemmon Street; thence binding on the 23 north side of said Lemmon Street, Easterly 246.0 feet, more or less, to the west 24 side of Lemmon Street, 24 feet wide, there situate; thence binding on the west and 25 26 north sides of last said Lemmon Street, the two following courses and distances; namely, Northerly 4.0 feet, and Easterly 84.0 feet, more or less, to intersect the 27 west side of Paca Street, 82.5 feet wide; thence binding on the west side of said 28

3	Westerly 330.0 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.
4	As delineated on Plat 114-A-13, prepared by the Survey Control Section and filed on May 15,
5	2006, in the Office of the Department of Public Works.
6	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and
7	opening of Lemmon Street and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in
8	accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and
9	regulations adopted by the Director of Public Works and filed with the Department of
10	Legislative Reference.
11	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
12	is enacted.
