Re: City Council Bill No. 10-0621-Residential Permit Parking - Area 2

Dear President and City Council Members:

You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 10-0621. City Council Bill 621 provides for maximum parking durations within the Morgan Residential Parking Area. The bill will limit parking durations for non-permit holders to one hour in any 1 or more parking spots anywhere within the Morgan Residential Parking Area.

Article 31, Section 10-19(a) provides that "at any time after a Parking Management Plan has been adopted by administrative regulation, the Mayor and City Council may enact an Ordinance rescinding or modifying the administrative regulation and the Parking Management Plan created by it." City Council Bill10-0621 provides for a modification of the Morgan Parking Management Plan pursuant to Section 10-19(a).

Base on the foregoing, the Law Department approves City Council Bill 10-0621 for form and legal sufficiency.
