AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Telecommunications Tax – Rate

FOR the purpose of modifying the rate of the telecommunications tax; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the imposition and collection of a telecommunications tax.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 25. Public Utilities Taxes

Part 1. Telecommunications Tax

§ 25-3. Rate of tax.

The rate of the tax imposed by this Part 1 is:

(1) ~~[\$0.35]~~ \$0.40 per month or part of a month for each Centrex local exchange access line or trunk line; and

1 (2) [\$3.50] \$4.00 per month or part of a month for every other telecommunica-
2 tions line, whether a residence, business, PBX local exchange, or other wired
3 or wireless telecommunications line.

4 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
5 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
6 Ordinance.

7 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** *That the tax rates established in Section 1 of*
8 *this Ordinance, may not be increased for residential customers as long as the Memorandum of*
9 *Understanding referred to in Section 2 of this Ordinance is in effect and the Associations are in*
10 *compliance with its terms and conditions.*

11 **SECTION 3 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
12 is enacted for all telecommunication lines in service on or after July 1, 2010, and billed on or
13 after August 1, 2010.
