**INTRODUCTION** – Approval for the Exchange of a Class B-D-7 License to a Class A-7 License for Use at 1807-1811 Baker Street, 21217

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of providing the required approval under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev. § 12-902.1(d)(1) to allow the license holder holding a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License issued for use at 1807-1811 Baker Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21217 to apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to exchange their Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License.

**COMMENTS** – During the 2018 Legislative Session, the Maryland General Assembly passed Senate Bill 519, allowing existing B-D-7 license holders to exchange their existing license for an A-7 license, contingent on a supportive resolution advancing through the Baltimore City Council. Council Resolution 22-0094R is the resolution necessary to allow for the exchange of the existing B-D-7 license for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License at 1807-1811 Baker Street.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION** – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation foresees no direct fiscal or operational impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** towards the advancement of Council Resolution 22-0094R.
