 the B-3-3 Zoning District the properties known as 1100 and 1110 East Baltimore Street (Ward 5,
 Section 7, Block 1338, Lots 1 and 2/3), as outlined in red on the amended plat accompanying
 this Ordinance.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
- shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
