17	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents State funding from the State of
18	Maryland Department of Natural Resources Community Catalyst Fund in excess of the revenue
19	relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
20	Fiscal Year 2025.
21	That funding could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
22	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
23	On February 7, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
24	Council.

## Council Bill 25-0045

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$90,000 shall be made available to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 654 (Urban
Forestry) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to
provide funding for addressing the pressing concerns surrounding the detrimental impact of deer
on the forested natural areas within Baltimore City parks, particularly those affecting forest
ecology in EPA IRA Disadvantaged Communities. The source of revenue for this appropriation
is the State funding from the State of Maryland Department of Natural Resources Community
Catalyst Fund in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of
Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
