INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill 23-0352 introduced by Councilmember Conway.

PURPOSE

This bill would change the name of the playground and pavilion at Alhambra Park, located at 5200 Alhambra Avenue, to the Phyllis Gilmore Playground and Pavilion.

BRIEF HISTORY

Phyllis Gilmore is a dedicated community leader in North Baltimore who currently serves as president of the Woodbourne-McCabe Neighborhood Association and vice-president of the York Road Partnership. Her efforts on behalf of Woodbourne-McCabe have been invaluable in improving and revitalizing the neighborhood. One of her many accomplishments include securing a new playground and improvements to Alhambra Park at the heart of the Woodbourne-McCabe community. For these and all of her related efforts, this bill renames the playground and pavilion on the West side of Alhambra Park in her honor.
