8	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by
9	§§ 5-305(a) and 5-308 of Article 32 - Zoning, permission is granted for a variance from the
20	requirements of § 16-406 (Table 16-406: Required Off-Street Parking) for
1	off-street parking.

1	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
2	accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
3	Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
4	shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
5	and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
6	Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
7	Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
8	the Zoning Administrator.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
