The Baltimore City Office of Information and Technology (BCIT) has completed its review of Council Bill 23-0339 for the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$500,000.00 to the Baltimore City Office of Information and Technology – PRJ002417 (922029 117-029 Citywide Cyber Security Systems Upgrade), to provide funding for upgrading Citywide cyber security systems; and providing for a special effective date.

This supplemental appropriation of \$500,000 was committed from the surplus and is made available due to material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated. This funding will allow BCIT to enhance the security capabilities of the City’s cybersecurity infrastructure.
