Re: **City Council Bill 09-0298 City Streets - Opening – Hunter Street**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0298, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and opening Hunter Street, extending from the north side of a 10-foot alley, laid out in the rear of the properties known as 210 through 218/220-222 East Preston Street, Northerly 94.1 feet, more or less, to the south side of a 7-foot alley, laid out in the rear of the properties known as 209 through 217 East Mount Royal Avenue, as shown on Plat 338-A-21A in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

The opening and closing of this street will facilitate the owner of the adjoining apartment buildings, Osprey-Bolton Square Printers, LLC, to create a courtyard between both buildings. The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 09-0298.
