**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Supplementary Mayoralty Capital Project Fund Capital Appropriation –  
Baltimore City Information Technology – \$13,650,000**

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Mayoralty Capital Project Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$13,650,000 to the Baltimore City Information Technology – PRJ002423 ~~911111-127-116~~ (Broadband for Public Housing Sites), to provide funding for the Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the Housing Authority of Baltimore City to install broadband internet service at public housing sites; and providing for a special effective date.

**Recitals**

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Housing Authority of Baltimore City - ~~Capital funds~~ City in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

~~This additional revenue~~ That grant could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.

~~The agency responsible for the production of this additional revenue is the Housing Authority of Baltimore City.~~

On November 5, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

1       **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
2 \$13,650,000 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Information Technology – PRJ002423  
3 ~~911111-127-116~~ (Broadband for Public Housing Sites) as a Supplementary Mayoralty Capital  
4 Project Fund Capital Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2026, to provide funding for the  
5 Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the Housing Authority of Baltimore City  
6 to install broadband internet service at public housing sites. The source of revenue for this  
7 appropriation is a grant from the Housing Authority of Baltimore City ~~-Capital funds~~ in excess  
8 of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the  
9 tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

10       **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
11 enacted.
