

RE: City Council Bill Report Request (11-0287R)

The Mayor's Office of Information Technology (MOIT) follows the Mayor's executive order under the "Baltimore City Residents First Program" to seek and hire Baltimore City residents first who meet the qualifications for MOIT positions. Many of the technical positions in MOIT require specialized skill sets that have been difficult to find in the local area. Even in this tough time of economic challenges, MOIT always considers local hiring first, but also realizes that it must complete the mission of providing quality technology services and support to meet the needs of our citizens, businesses, and government agencies of Baltimore City.

MOIT believes that by mandating the adoption of a policy to meet local hiring goals would force MOIT to hire under qualified individuals and/or prevent MOIT from filling positions, which will impact technology services provided to Baltimore City.
