Dear President and City Council Members:

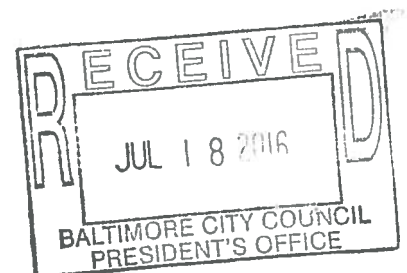
The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0691 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill proposes to amend the Parking Management Plan for RPP Area 41 to authorize six Special Permits for the Baltimore Station, 140 W. West Street, which will be valid 7 days a week from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight.

Art. 31, Subtitle 10 of the Baltimore City Code governs residential permit parking. Sec. 10-19(a) states “[a]t any time after a Parking Management Plan has been adopted by administrative regulation, the Mayor and City Council may enact an Ordinance rescinding or modifying the administrative regulation and the Parking Management Plan created by it.” City Council Bill 16-0691 is consistent with this authority.

The Law Department, therefore, approves Council Bill 16-0691 for form and legal sufficiency.
