I am herein reporting on City Council Bill #11-0752.

The purpose of the bill is to condemn and open certain streets and alleys in the area bounded by Ensor Street, Monument Street, Aisquith Street, and Orleans Street and lying within the Oldtown Urban Renewal Project, as shown on Plat 314-A-1D in the Office of the Department of General Services; and provide for a special effective date.

This bill would enable consolidation of several properties in preparation for redevelopment of the Oldtown Mall into a mixed-use commercial center. The new development would include a grocery store, mixed-income residential units and landscaping, with improved connectivity to the surrounding communities. The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of this bill.
