The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill#14-0462, which is for the purpose of including two additional properties within the Guilford Residential Permit Parking Area.

The City Council Bill #14-0462 proposes to include the following two areas in the existing Guilford Area Residential Permit Parking (RPP) program: (1) the unit blocks of St. Martin's Road and East Bishops Road; and (2) 3705 and 3801 N. Charles Street. This action benefits the community by adding availability of on-street parking for the community.

Therefore, the Department of Planning supports the purpose of City Council Bill #14-0462, as the inclusion of the two properties in the program increases the availability of on-street parking, and recommends the passage of City Council Bill #14-0462.
