- 2 FOR the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 420 North Haven Street (Block 6265A, Lot 011), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the I-2 Zoning 3 District to the C-3 Zoning District. 4

- SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 11 Sheet 58 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the I-2 Zoning District to the 12 C-3 Zoning District the property known as 420 North Haven Street (Block 6265A, Lot 011), as 13 14 outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 15 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 16 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 18 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 20 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator. 22
