


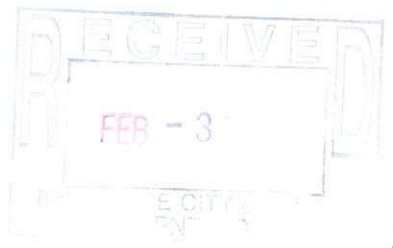

The Environmental Control Board (ECB) does not oppose the bill proposed for the purpose of conforming certain provisions of the Baltimore City Floodplain Management Code cross referencing with the Zoning Code.

It is the mission of ECB to adjudicate civil citations when issued by city agencies in accordance with Article 1, Section 40. Having the Floodplain Management Code supported by enforceable citations will help ensure compliance with the code. However, Article 13 § 9 is currently not enforceable with a citation to be heard under the authority of ECB, but ECB does address the Zoning provision #-107 dealing with unauthorized storage of vehicles.
