Re: City Council Bill No. 16-730 Conditional Use - Amending Ordinance 01-236

Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill No. 16-730 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of City Council Bill No. 16-730 is to amend Ordinance 01-236 to increase the maximum bed capacity of the residential substance abuse treatment facility and to clarify that, while no outpatient program may be conducted on the site to provide services to the general public, patients from the operator's other facilities may be transported to and from this site to receive treatment as necessary; and conforming certain language to reflect the current Zoning Code reference.

The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and recommends approval to the passage of City Council Bill No. 16-730.
